



In Bathurst, New Brunswick, [Bylaw #2005-17](#) forbids anyone over the age of fourteen from trick or treating for candy. Additionally, Hallowe-en festivities, including the wearing of any facial disguise, must conclude by 7:00pm and always be held on October 31st.

Failure to comply can result in a provincial offences prosecution subject to a minimum \$80.00 fine and maximum \$200.00 fine.
